The Maintenance team performs routine and preventative maintenance to maintain the physical integrity and back end systems of Nimmo Bay Resort. A successful Maintenance team member will work collaboratively with the Maintenance team to ensure that the maintenance systems are running and preventively maintained. They are responsible for cleanliness and upkeep of property grounds, facilities, equipment, and various utility systems.

Our full-time shift is 2 weeks on, 2 weeks off, and our operating season runs from the beginning of May until the end of October. Transportation is provided to Nimmo Bay from Port McNeill on Vancouver Island, B.C., so the ideal candidate will be able to commute to and from Port McNeill for all shifts while working onsite.
